## One River

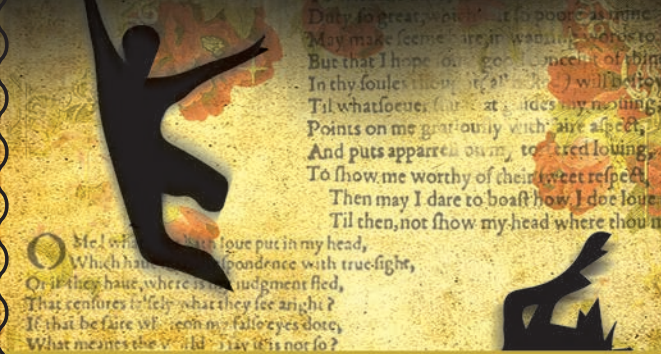
